

ORDINANCE 2004(105A)

AN AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE 2004(105), TO PROVIDE AN ADDITIONAL DEFENSE TO A VIOLATION OF THE FOREGOING ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF PETAL, MISSISSIPPI:

SECTION 1: Ordinance 2004(105), is amended to add:

Section 4: DEFENSES

- A. (10) Engaged in activities, under the directions of the minor's parent or guardian when the minor is properly enrolled in a "Nonpublic School", in full compliance of 37-13-91 of the Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended.

SECTION 2: Except as amended herein, Ordinance 2004(105) remains in full force and effect.

The above and foregoing amendment to Ordinance 2004(105), having been reduced to writing, and presented to the Mayor and Board of Aldermen, with the following results;


