

ORDINANCE 2007 (4-1)

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING AND AMENDING THE
WRECKER SERVICE POLICY IN THE CITY OF PETAL

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF
THE CITY OF PETAL, MISSISSIPPI:**

SECTION 1. Section 2 of Ordinance 2007 (4) is hereby amended as follows:

Section 2. Non-Preference wrecker service call list established.

- B. Must provide a secure place of storage within the City Limits hauled by the wrecker service. A secure place of storage is considered, one which meets the following minimum requirements.
 - 1. Area surrounded by a six (6) foot fence and capable of being locked to prevent casual access.
 - 2. The area must be capable of storing a minimum of twenty (20) vehicles.

SECTION II. The above and foregoing amendment to Ordinance 2007(4), shall take effect and be in force within thirty (30) days of today's date.

SECTION III. Except as amended herein, Ordinance 2007 (4) remains in full force and effect.

The above and foregoing Ordinance, having been reduced to writing, the same was introduced and read and a vote was taken thereon, first section by section, then upon the Ordinance as a whole, with the following results:


